THEODICY #1. The Fantasy of Simplicity




Not a simple issue; don't expect a simple answer.


THEODICY #2. The Inherency of Complexity

- God created us because He wanted to share His love, and engage in loving relationship with His creation.
- · God created us in His image.

· God created us with a free will.

• God was also willing to accept the ramifications of that decision.

- · We might freely choose to reject Him.
- · We might freely choose not to love.
- · We might freely choose to do evil.
